- 1. Immunopathology of viral hepatitis: molecular biology and viral genetics (Polymerase chain reaction, Sequencing, Cloning, Immunoblotting, Northern e Southern-Blot analysis)
- 2. The heterogeneity of hepatitis C virus (HCV) and hepatitis G virus (HGV): isolation of human biologic material of the viral genome and its nucleotide and amino acid characteristics
- 3. Antibody response against synthetic epitopes and their clinical-pathologic significance in human HCV and HGV infections
- 4. Messenger RNA and their modulations in the liver in experimental conditions of hypoxia-regeneration
- 5. The expression of molecular adhesion and its physio-pathological role in patients with liver disease
- 6. The acute phase response and damage of free oxygen radicals in patients with acute and chronic liver diseases and with hepatocellular carcinoma
