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ERASMUS+ Programme Key Action 1 – Student Mobility for Traineeship CALL 2023/2024 FOR THE AWARD OF MOBILITY GRANTS FOR TRAINEESHIP/RESEARCH FOR PHD STUDENTS

Application opening period: 21 FEBRUARY 2024 – 31 MAY 2024

This notice is an open call with <u>no ranking list</u>. The application window may be closed before 31 May 2024 due to the exhaustion of funds available for the provision of traineeship grants. How to proceed:

- check participation requirements (see art. 2);

- identify an available foreign institution/entity in which to carry out the internship and get the *Erasmus+ Traineeship Letter of Intent* signed (see art. 2);

- apply on Esse3 (see art. 7).

If the candidate meets the participation requirements and the application is valid, he/she will be considered eligible for the placement.

The application must be submitted on Esse3 at least one month before the start of the traineeship.

ART.1 - WHAT IS ERASMUS+ PLACEMENT MOBILITY?

The 'Erasmus for Traineeship' action of the Erasmus+ programme provides access to traineeships in companies, training and research centres, and higher education institutions located in one of the countries participating in the programme.

Erasmus+ provides for the repeatability of Erasmus experience for study and/or traineeship up to a maximum of 12 months per study cycle (phd course) regardless of the number and types of mobility (traineeship or study) undertaken.

Art. 2 - APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PHD STUDENT CANDIDATES

Eligibility Requirements for the Internship Grant:

a) be duly enrolled in a doctorate course XXXVII, XXXVIII; XXXIX with administrative headquarters in Udine. If the applicant is entitled to the financial contribution, the money will be transferred as long as the applicant has paid the doctorate enrolment fees;

b) be up to date with the payment of university fees at the University of Udine;

c) PhD students with a PhD scholarship paid with European fundings FSE+ 2021/2027 and PNRR cannot apply since PhD students must not receive other EU fundings derived from other programmes/actions financed by the European Union which would overlap, even partially, with the Erasmus+ Traineeship period.

d) not receive any other financial contribution from University of Udine for the research period abroad, except for the doctorate financial contribution bonus for the period abroad;

e) not have participated and not participate, during 2023/24, in other international mobility programmes financed thanks to the application for mobility calls opened by University of Udine International Office;







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f) not be resident in the country where the traineeship is to take place;

g) must not have already used the maximum number of months of mobility permitted under the Erasmus+ programme in the study cycle. The count must also include the Erasmus placement being applied for under this call for applications;

h) have identified, together with their supervisor, a public or private foreign host organisation of an adequate scientific, cultural and/or technical level, willing to host the doctoral student and to assign a tutor for the period of activity;

i) be in possession of the *Erasmus+ Traineeship Letter of Intent* (Annex 2) **signed by the organisation/body where the traineeship will take place**;

j) maintain the status of doctoral student for the duration of the mobility. Obtaining the doctoral degree during the mobility period will result in forfeiture of the grant and the return of the sums received.

ART. 3 - DURATION AND PERIOD OF STAY ABROAD

The eligible mobility period for traineeships is from **01 March 2024 to 30 September 2024.** The minimum period of mobility is 2 months (shorter periods are not recognised and no contribution will be paid). The maximum period of mobility is 6 months. The placement must end by 30 September 2024.

ART. 4 - PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

"Erasmus+ Traineeship can be carried out in the countries participating in the Programme (the current EU Member States; the countries of the European Economic Area: Iceland, Lichtenstein, Norway; the acceding countries excluding Turkey) or in one of the partner countries of Region 14 (Faroe Islands, the United Kingdom, Switzerland) and Region 13 ex 5 (Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Vatican City State).

Please note: a visa is required to carry out the Erasmus placement in the UNITED KINGDOM.

A CoS (certificate of sponsorship) is required to apply for the visa. The deadline for applying for the CoS (certificate of sponsorship) is approximately 3 months before the start date of the placement. For any other information, visit the UK website: https://www.gov.uk/.

ART. 5 - AVAILABLE BUDGET

The funding allocated to the University of Udine by the European Union makes it possible to provide candidates with internship grants that will be distributed until the available budget is exhausted. The winners will be awarded a monthly lump sum FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION ERASMUS+ of between € 500,00 and € 400,00 depending on the country of destination (see table below).

An ADDITIONAL ERASMUS+ MONTHLY FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION of \in 250,00 will be provided to candidates with ISEE 2023 equal to or less than \in 26.306,25 (MUR - DECREE. 204 del 23/02/2023);

As of the new Erasmus+ programme 2021-2027, there will be an ad hoc CONTRIBUTION of \in 50.00 and a maximum of 4 days of individual support for travel days for so-called GREEN TRAVEL, i.e., for reaching of the host location by sustainable means of transport (train, bus).

ART. 6 - INSURANCE COVER

In order to participate in the mobility courses, the student must be covered by the following insurances:

- a) HEALTH INSURANCE: basic health care is guaranteed by the EHIC European Health Insurance Card (http://www.salute.gov.it/portale/temi/p2_6.jsp?lingua=italiano&id=624&area=Assistenza%20sanitari a&menu=TEAM) Beneficiaries are required to check in person with their local health services authority (ASL) the health care conditions in the country of destination (information also at http://www.salute.gov.it/portale/temi/p2_6.jsp?id=3666&area=Assistenza+health&menu=italian&lang uage=italian&countries=&motives=5&charge=) and to take out, where this is not provided, an appropriate policy to guarantee adequate health insurance cover;
- b) CIVIL LIABILITY: the home institute guarantees civil liability insurance cover for all enrolled students with companies operating in the sector;
- c) INSURANCE AGAINST ACCIDENTS IN THE WORKPLACE: your institute provides insurance cover against accidents at work with INAIL under the system of insurance cover on behalf of the State (Consolidated Law, INAIL, Italian Presidential Decree nos. 1124/65 and n. 156/99).

ART. 7 - SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION

The online application will be available from 21 February 2024 to 31 May 2024 at 1.00 p.m. and must be submitted at least 1 months before the start of the placement.

To apply the student must:

- 1. access Esse3 with their credentials;
- 2. select the item 'Mobility Notices';
- 3. select "Erasmus+ Traineeship a.y.2023-2024_dott_spec";
- 4. fill in the 'application form' (select 'fill in the form');
- 5. choose the generic destination of the country in which the placement will take place, giving preference '1' for example to 'France Generic foreign placement location' and indicating in the 'Notes field' the name of the host organisation where the placement will take place;
- 6. attach the required documents (*Phd Student Candidate Application Form* and *Erasmus+ Traineeship Letter of Intent*);
- 7. Make the application final by the deadline by selecting "Print application receipt". Printing confirms closure of the application and makes the data no longer editable.

The following documents in pdf format must be attached to the online application:

- a) completed and signed **phd student candidate application form** (attachment 1 to the page on the University website: international/study and work placement opportunities abroad/Erasmus+traineeship);
- b) letter of acceptance from the host institute/organisation completed and signed by the host institute (attachment 2 *Erasmus+ Traineeship Letter of Intent*), fax or scanned copies are also accepted (template on the University website page: international/study and traineeship opportunities abroad/Erasmus+ traineeship).

Art. 8 - PROCEDURE MANAGER

Pursuant to Art. 4 of Law 241 of 7 August 1990 "New rules on administrative procedures and the right of access to administrative documents", the person in charge of the procedure is Dr. Manuela Croatto, head of the Directorate of Education and Student Services at the University of Udine.

Please be informed that, pursuant to Article 71 of Italian Presidential Decree 445 of 28 December 2000, the Administration reserves the right to carry out appropriate checks, also on a sample basis, and in all cases in which grounded doubts arise as to the truthfulness of the substitute declarations.

In addition to the criminal liability provided for by law, making false declarations to the university administration will lead to automatic and irrevocable exclusion from the selection.

Art. 10 - PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Personal data contained in applications for participation in this call for applications will be handled in accordance with the requirements of Legislative Decree no.196 of 30 June 2003 "Personal Data Protection Code" and with Article 13 GDPR 679/16 EU Regulation on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data.

ART. 12 - IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES

If the application is successful, the phd student will receive an *information booklet* by e-mail from SPES for the completion of all the administrative and teaching procedures required by the programme.

The allocation of the financial contribution is always conditional upon:

- _ formal acceptance of the student's application by the foreign host subject/body through signing of the Learning Agreement for Traineeship between the parties (phd student, University of Udine, host subject/body);
- signing of the financial agreement between the student and the University of Udine; -
- the trainee's obtaining of any residence permits and visas if a non-EU student. -

The method of payment of the Erasmus+ for Traineeship mobility grant in favour of the student is exclusively by crediting the bank account in the name of (or jointly with) the beneficiary. The amount of the mobility grant will be paid in 2 instalments: a pre-financing of 80% at the beginning of the mobility period and a balance of 20% at the end of the mobility period.

The traineeship can only start after all the required documents have been submitted to DIDS - Mobility and International Relations Office.
