The original transcript of records (no carbon copy is accepted) with the exams done by the Italian student can be given or sent directly to him/her OR to the International Relations and Mobility Office of I UDINE01.

The Learning Agreement or the changed Learning Agreement has to be given to the Italian student who will submit to the approval of the professor coordinator.

Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINEO1 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.

A Transcript of Records will be issued no later than 12 weeks after the assessment period has finished.

#### 4. Termination

A notice of at least one academic year should be given in the event of a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges. This means that a decision notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The same principle applies to any proposed amendment to the data under B to F above, unless mutually agreed upon. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
