- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to iss@uniud.it). I UDINE01 cannot guarantee the acceptance of any other nomination modality by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- **I UDINE01** will send the letter of acceptance and information package within 8 weeks from reception of the nomination letter.
- Erasmus incoming students at **I UDINEO1** have to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine. Should they fail to do so, the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent directly to the students' personal address by I UDINEO1 within 5 weeks.

4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 2019 will only take effect as of 1 September 2020+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
