#### PL WROCLAW01: DISABLED

The Learning Agreement or the changed Learning Agreement has to be given to the Italian student who will submit to the approval of the professor coordinator.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within max. 5 weeks after the receipt of the complete application.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement:

In the event of unilateral termination of the inter-institutional agreement, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1.

Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

- I UDINE01 will send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail. It cannot be guaranteed another modality to nominate Erasmus students from I UDINE01.

- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to <u>iss@uniud.it</u>). **I UDINE01** cannot guarantee the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- I UDINEO1 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- Erasmus incoming student at **IUDINE01** has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by IUDINE01 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.
