 I UDINEO1 cannot guarantee the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).

- I UDINEO1 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- Erasmus incoming student at **I UDINE01** has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINE01 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.

Termination or modification of the agreement:

A unilateral decision to discontinue or to change the exchanges notified to the other party by September 20/../ will only take effect from the October of the following new academic year.

UNIVERSITY OF CORDOBA:

- 2. After having received the paper application (printed online application) the letter of admission will be send within a max of 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

Either party may terminate this Agreement:

- (a) by giving to the other not less than one academic years' notice in writing;
- (b) with immediate effect by notice in writing if the other party commits a material breach (which may consist of a series of minor breaches) of the terms of this Agreement;
- (c) with immediate effect by notice in writing if the other party is subject to a change of control, becomes insolvent, is unable to pay its debts as and when due or otherwise ceases to exist.

If notice of termination has been given under this clause, the parties shall:

- (a) agree in writing a mechanism for ensuring that students are able to complete their studies at the Host Institution or other suitable institution;
- (b) agree in writing a timetable for the return of Visiting Members of Staff to their Home Institution;
- (c) cease to promote or market the inter-institutional agreement and not register any new students.

The parties shall attempt to resolve in good faith any dispute arising between them out of the operation of this Agreement. If the dispute cannot be resolved informally, it shall be referred to a senior post-holder within each institution.

Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
