<p>Sydney University</p>		<p>24 credit points (18 CP) at Sydney = 30 ECTS at Udine</p>	<p>6 credit points at Sydney = 7,5 ECTS at Udine</p>	<p>The Sydney University assesses enrolment status by the number of credit points a student is taking, not the number of classes or number of contact hours. Most units of study are each worth 6 credit points. Students will normally be required to enrol in 4 units of study at 6 credit points each per semester. 24 credit points equates to the effort expected of a full-time student, studying 36-48 hours per week. A credit point should therefore equate notionally to a minimum expectation of 1.5-2 hours of student effort.</p>	
<p>Macquarie University</p>		<p>12 credit points at Macquarie = 30 ECTS at Udine</p>	<p>3 credit points at Macquarie = 7,5 ECTS at Udine</p>	<p>A full-time undergraduate study load is 9 credit points or more in a full Session (Session 1 or 2), which is a minimum of 3 units. The maximum number of units a student can study in a full Session is four. Each credit point in a one session unit would indicate that you should expect to spend about 3 hours each week on that unit (including any class contact hours).</p>
