The maximum number of courses that students can take at Laurier is 5 courses. A half-credit (0.5) is normally conducted over a four-month period (September-December).
University of Guelph (sede anglofona)	5 credit points at Guelph = 60 ECTS at Udine	2,5 credit points at Guelph = 30 ECTS at Udine	0,5 credit points at Guelph = 6 ECTS at Udine		A full-time course load for undergraduate (Bachelor's) students at University of Guelph is 2.0 to 2.5 credits. Most UofGuelph courses are 0.5 credits each, therefore, our students usually take 4 to 5 courses per semester. Graduate (Masters) students usually take 1 - 3 courses per semester (0.5 - 1.5 credits). 2.75 credits is the maximum course load a University of Guelph student can take per semester.
Univeristy of Windsor (sede anglofona)	10 UWindsor classes = 60 ECTS at Udine	5 UWindsor classes = 30 ECTS at Udine	3 credit points at UWindsor = 6 ECTS at Udine		The maximum you can take is 5 classes. Most students will take 4 or 5 classes a semester. If you are taking a class with a required "lab" this does NOT count as a seperate class. For students from Europe, a one semester class at the University of Windsor is normally worth 6 ECTS (in UWindsor terms each class is worth 3 credits). If you are required to take the equivalent of 30 ECTS per semester, you will need to be registered in 5 UWindsor classes. The ONLY official listing of classes where you can see a schedule of classes for the coming semester is the Student Information System (SIS).

To qualify for full time status: enrolment in 18 to 30 credits per academic year is required. To qualify for part time status: enrolment in a minimum of 3 credits to a maximum of 15 credits in an academic year*</p> <p>*Academic year : September to April</p>

Minimum of 12 credits per trimester for undergraduate programs (Bachelor's). Minimum of 9 credits per trimester for graduate programs (Master's and Doctoral).</p>
<p>Université du Québec à Montréal (sede francofona)</p>	<p>30 credit points at UQAM (undergraduate) = 60 ECTS at Udine</p>	<p>15 credit points (min. 12 CP) at UQAM (undergraduate) = 30 ECTS at Udine</p>	<p>3 credit points at UQAM = 6 ECTS at Udine</p>	<p>A session lasts 15 weeks and a course generally is worth 3 credits. A 3-credit course at UQAM is equivalent to a 6-credit ECTS course. At the undergraduate (Bachelor's) level, a full-time student at UQAM must take a minimum of 4 courses (12 credits) per semester, the normal workload being 5 courses (15 credits). At the graduate level, the minimum number of courses (credits) required for full-time enrolment varies by program. Participation in orientation days is mandatory and, therefore, your arrival date in Montreal must precede the orientation day. Plan to arrive one week before the start of classes.</p>

A credit equals 15classroom hours; most courses are 3credits (3hours per week for 15weeks). For Europeans, at the undergraduate level, 1UdeM credit= 2ECTS credits. • At the Graduate level (Master's and PhD), students must be registered to a minimum of 6 credits and a maximum of 9 credits of courses or research. A 3 credit course at the Graduate level equals to 8 to 10 ECTS credits. <p>Please note that this is not an average: you must be registered for the minimum number of credits for each term.</p>
