- 2. The receiving institution SI LJUBLIA01 will send its decision within 8 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution SI LJUBLIA01 no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- I UDINE01 will send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail. It cannot be guaranteed another modality to nominate Erasmus students from I UDINE01.
- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to <u>iss@uniud.it</u>). I **UDINEO1** cannot guarantee the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- I UDINEO1 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- Erasmus incoming student at I UDINEO1 has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINEO1 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.
 - 4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
