D BOCHUM01	The grading scheme usually comprises five levels (with numerical equivalents; intermediate grades may be given): "Sehr Gut" (1) = Excellent/Very Good; "Gut" (2) = Good; "Befriedigend" (3) = Satisfactory; "Ausreichend" (4) = Sufficient; "Nicht ausreichend" (5) = Non-Sufficient/Fail. The minimum passing grade is "Ausreichend" (4). Some departments at RUB use grades given in percentage (100-0) or grade points (18-0).
