- CUAS Outgoing students will be selected for the study abroad semester according to their academic results, motivation and language skills.
- Incoming students to CUAS must submit either a language certificate ie. IELTS or TOEFL <u>OR</u> a Language Proficiency Recommendation signed by the language lecturer from the sending institution. Should this not be possible, the CUAS International Departmental Coordinators reserve the right to conduct a Skype interview with the nominated Incoming students in order to assess the language ability to ensure academically successful experience at CUAS. In that case, the interview is a part of the application procedure.
- The Incoming students are to register through an online application system. The information is given on <a href="http://www.fh-kaernten.at/en/international-office/incoming-exchange-students.html">http://www.fh-kaernten.at/en/international-office/incoming-exchange-students.html</a> Deadlines for Incoming Exchange Students applications are: 31 May for the fall semester and 30 November for the spring semester.
- Incoming Staff Members for Teaching and Training Mobility should apply by CUAS at least in the semester before the exchange is planned. In case of limited capacities by CUAS a new date for the exchange could be offered. Due to organisational reasons, exchanges within the months of July-September, and February are not possible and in the months of October and March are not recommended.

- 2. The I UDINE01 will send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by  $\underline{e-mail}$ . It cannot be guaranteed another modality to nominate Erasmus students from I UDINE01 (such as online nominations etc.).
- 3. Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to <a href="iss@uniud.it">iss@uniud.it</a>). It cannot be guaranteed the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc.).
- 4. The I UDINE01 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- 5. ASPITTAL01 as a receiving institution will send its decision within six weeks after the application deadline.

- 6. Erasmus incoming student at the I UDINE01 has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by the I UDINE01 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.
- 7. A Transcript of Records will be issued by ASPITTAL01 as a receiving institution ideally six weeks after the assessment period and no later than 4 weeks after the semester ended.
- 8. Termination or modification of the agreement:

A unilateral decision to discontinue or to change the exchanges notified to the other party by September 20/../ will only take effect from the October of the following new academic year.
