## **Bilateral Inter-Institutional Agreement**

Key Action 1 Learning Mobility for Higher Education Students and Staff

among EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme <sup>1</sup>

The institutions agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. They commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, including automatic recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution as agreed in the Learning Agreement and confirmed in the Transcript of Records, or according to the learning outcomes of the modules completed abroad, as described in the Course Catalogue, in line with the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System. The institutions agree on exchanging their mobility related data in line with the technical standards of the European Student Card Initiative / Erasmus Goes Digital, and consequently to sign digitally this Inter-institutional agreement as soon as technically possible.

### Grading systems of the institutions

The information will facilitate the interpretation of each grade awarded to students and will facilitate the credit transfer by the sending institution.

This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
