- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the University of Gdansk institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. I UDINE01 will send a detailed Erasmus nomination list <u>bv e-mail</u>. It cannot be guaranteed another modality to nominate Erasmus students from I UDINE01.
- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to iss@uniud.it). I UDINE01 cannot guarantee the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- I UDINE01 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination

Erasmus incoming student at I UDINE01 has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINE01 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.

 Termination of the agreement or Changes in the data set above can be amended annually, if communicated before January 1st. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
