- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement The present Bilateral Agreement will be valid for the academic year(s) mentioned above unless either side terminates the present Agreement in writing by June 1st of the year prior to the academic year concerned. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible.
- **I UDINE01** will send a detailed Erasmus nomination list <u>by e-mail</u>. I UDINE01 cannot guarantee any other nomination modality.
- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to <u>iss@uniud.it</u>). **I UDINEO1** cannot guarantee the acceptance of any other nomination modality by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- I UDINEO1 will send the letter of acceptance and information package within 8 weeks from reception of the nomination letter.
- Erasmus incoming students at **I UDINE01** have to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine. Should they fail to do so, the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent directly to the students' personal address by I UDINE01 within 5 weeks.
