
The Swiss Government finances all activities from and to Switzerland mentioned in this contract. Should the current status of Switzerland change with regard to Erasmus + , the regulations will be adjusted and partners informed in due time.

The numbers mentioned in this contract are not a commitment; reciprocity and/or prolongation may be discussed. For each academic year both parties will have the opportunity to review the exchange agreed upon in this initial paper. Upon mutual agreement, amendments of the mobility figures can be made.

The above parties agree to co-operate in the activities shown below in the frame of the Swiss-European Mobility Programme, according to the principles of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE). Both parties will facilitate information on any issue that can facilitate the mobility of students and staff.

The present agreement will be valid as long as Switzerland does not have the status of a Programme Country in Erasmus+. Within the framework of the interim solution, Switzerland does finance both student and staff mobility to Swiss universities.
