Call for proposal for ERC Advanced Grant - ERC-2020-ADG

ERC Advanced Grants are designed to support excellent Principal Investigators at the career stage at which they are already established research leaders with a recognised track record of research achievements. ERC Advanced Grant Principal Investigators are expected to be active researchers and to have a track record of significant research achievements in the last 10 years which must be presented in the application.

Principal Investigators will demonstrate at least 1 or more of the following benchmarks: 10 publications as main author; 3 major research monographs. Other alternative benchmarks which could be for example 5 patents granted; 10 calls per rate presented at international level conferences; member of the organizing committee of 3 established international congresses; max grant must: $2,500,000 \in$ for a period of 5 years. It is possible to request an additional of \in 1,000,000.

ERC Advanced Grants are designed to support excellent Principal Investigators at the career

The EC has launched the 2° Coronavirus call for an Expression for innovative and rapid health-related approaches to respond the pandemic and to deliver quick results for society. Call action types are RIA, IA and CSA COHORT. There are 5 topics: 2A (Repurposing of manufacturing), 2B (Medical technologies to improve surveillance and care), 2C (Social and economic impacts), 2D (Pan-European COVID-19 cohorts), 2E (Networking of existing EU and international cohorts of relevance.

Projects involve at least 3 entities from 3 different countries from the EU and Associated Countries (the average consortium size is around 10-12 participants). Evaluation: max 2 months after the deadline. Project costs are eligible from the day of submission, at the applicant's risk. Project outcomes should be rapid (within 3-24 months) and proposals can be concise to focus on the essential information. Project start: max 4 months after the deadline.

EIT Urban Mobility: COVID-19 Crisis Response call for Proposal 2020

EIT Urban Mobility has reallocated budgets to open a new call dedicated to addressing urban mobility challenges posed by COVID-19 crisis. The exceptional COVID-19 Crisis Response Call (COVID CRC) has simplified procedures and an accelerated process. Thematic areas: Innovation, Business creation, Academy, Factory, Regional innovation scheme, Citizen Engagement.

Project consortium shall consist of at least 2 entities from 2 different countries. Proposals should: have a proposed funding per project of up to EUR 700k; involve demonstrators such as cities, regional governments and transport providers or concession holders; have a solid scientific/technological background for the provision of passenger safety and mobility workers' wellbeing; Involve SMEs, industry and start-ups. Deadline 31 May 2020 at 16:00 CET.

CEPI call for proposals: Achieving an Unprecedented Acceleration of Vaccine Development and Global Manufacturing Capacity to Prevent COVID-19 Crisis

CEPI has launched a second call, to all types of organization, to submit proposals for funding applications to accelerate the development of a Covid-19 vaccine. The objective of this Call for Proposals is to support the rapid development of vaccines with a goal of achieving licensure/emergency authorization in 12-18 months or less and to ensure the availability of sufficient doses for wide-spread global deployment as soon as possible in 2021.

Eligible applicants are all types of organization: forprofit companies; non-profit organisations; international institutions and foundations; joint R&D ventures; government research organisations; and other vaccine developers. Applicants must be independent legal entities, or consortia comprised of legal entities. The main applicant, or for a consortium at least 1 of the members, must have experience in human vaccine development. Deadline: 30/06/2020. The Bio-based Industries Joint Undertaking is responsible for the implementation of open Call for proposals for Research and Innovation Actions (RIAs), Innovation Actions (IAs - DEMOs and FLAGs) and Coordination and Support Actions (CSAs), in line with the Horizon 2020 rules for participation. The Call 2020 is the seventh in a total of seven Calls between 2014 and 2020. 4 strategic orientations: Feedstock, Process, Products, and Market uptake. 16 topics: 5 RIAs, 4 CSAs, 4 DEMOs, 3 FLAGs.
