### **EU JOINT PROGRAMME - NEURODEGENERATIVE DISEASE RESEARCH: NOVEL IMAGING AND BRAIN STIMULATION METHODS AND TECHNOLOGIES RELATED TO NEURODEGENERATIVE DISEASES**

This transnational call invites proposals for ambitious, innovative, multinational and multidisciplinary collaborative research projects aimed at the development of novel and the advanced use of existing cutting-edge imaging and brain stimulation technologies related to neurodegenerative diseases.

The total made available for this call is about 18 million euros.

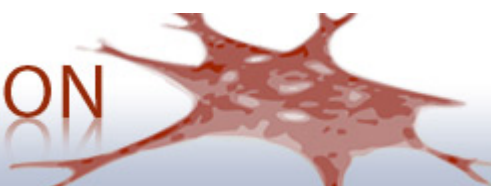
In Italy the funding institution is the Ministry of Health.

Deadlines for the electronic submission: pre-proposal – on March 3, 2020, 15:00 h C.E.T.; full proposal: June 30, 2020, 15:00 h C.E.T..

### **ERANET NEURON 2020 "SENSORY DISORDERS"- Call for proposal for Transnational Research Projects on Sensory Disorders**

The aim of this call is to facilitate multinational, collaborative research projects that will address important

sensory neurons, including receptor cells, the related neural pathways and connected brain areas.

Research proposals should cover at least one of the following areas:

a) Fundamental research addressing the pathogenesis and etiology of sensory disorders. This may include the development of innovative or shared resources and technologies. The relevance of the research to sensory systems disorders must be clearly described. Pre-clinical studies may be included. Any animal or cell models should already be established and validated.

b) Clinical research to develop novel strategies for prevention, diagnosis, patient stratification, therapy and/or rehabilitation for sensory disorders.

Funding for Italian partners (by Ministry of Health): total amount for this call 1.5 M€, expected 6 funded projects, funding project 250,000 €/project.

Deadline for the pre-proposal: March 10, 2020, 14:00 h C.E.T..

## ERA-NET COFUND ON FOOD SYSTEMS AND CLIMATE

This call aims to support scientifically excellent, trans-continental research, development and innovation projects that contribute to the knowledge base on food systems and climate change.

Applications must be submitted by project consortia that consist of research teams from a minimum of 4 countries from 2 continents (Europe, Africa or Latin America): at least 2 European countries (EU members and H2020 associated countries) and at least 2 from Latin American and/or African countries participating to the Call.

The submitted proposals must be multidisciplinary and should address at least one of the following topics:

- a. Assess climate change-related risks for food value chains, including impacts on producers, prices, availability, quality, international trade and food security, and resulting changes in consumer behaviours;
- b. Promote innovative technology deployment to build sustainable and resilient food value chains influenced by changing food needs and patterns, and to develop better efficiency of the inputs and outputs of food systems;
- c. Improve resilience and reduce volatility in agri-food production and food markets to sustainably improve food security in the context of climatic variation;
- d. Reduce food losses under climate change, including novel approaches to valorise side streams and reduce food waste.

This call aims to support research projects with potential impact to enable digital technology solutions for a transition towards more sustainable and resilient agri-food systems. Research projects should investigate, develop and test digital solutions for the rising demand for food, competition for land and other natural resources from other biomass uses, globalisation, and threats from animal or plant diseases, environmental and climatic changes, public health considerations and economic constraints.

Thematic areas are: topic 1 - Data-driven ICT platforms and solutions to improve the sustainability of agri-food Systems, topic 2 - Identify and address barriers for adoption of ICT technologies in the agri-food systems

The Italian funding institution is the Ministry for agricultural, food and forestry policies and the available resources are 300,000 €.

Deadline for the submission of the pre-proposal is on March 3, 2020, 13:00 h C.E.T..
