JUSTICE PROGRAMME - JUST-JACC-AG-2020

The aims of this call are to contribute to the effective and coherent application of EU criminal law in the area of the rights of persons suspected or accused of crime (procedural rights priority) and in the in the area of the rights of victims of crime (victims' rights priority). Projects ensuring maximum practical benefits and impact for the target groups will be more favorably assessed than theoretical projects consisting mainly of research and other analytical activities.

ERANET COFUND URBAN ACCESSIBILITY AND CONNECTIVITY (ENUAC)

The call is divided into five challenges. 1 Solutions for an integrated approach on sustainable urban physical mobility and transport, and digital connectivity. 2 Develop innovative mobility systems and services. 3 Transform urban spaces for sustainable urban mobility and accessibility at local level. 4 Develop effective policy options for a shift towards sustainable urban accessibility and connectivity. 5 Change behaviours towards sustainable urban accessibility and connectivity.
