Why are my personal data processed?

We process your data to carry out the following activities:

1. Communications relating to initiatives, activities, events of an institutional nature

What are my rights?

If the processing is based on consent, you can revoke it at any time. In addition, you always have the right to request access, rectification, deletion (compatibly with the data controller's retention obligations) and portability of your data; you can request the restriction of processing and you have the right to object to it as well as to the Guarantor for the protection of personal data.

WHY IS MY DATA PROCESSED?

We process your personal data according to the purposes set out and on the basis of specific conditions of lawfulness of the processing, which we indicate as follows:

Treatment

Legal framework

Communications relating to initiatives, activities, events of an institutional nature the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes - the data subject has given his or her explicit consent to the processing of those personal data for one or more specific purposes, except where Union or Member State law provides that the data subject may not revoke the prohibition set out in paragraph 1

In the event that you refuse to provide your data, when the processing is based on a contract or a **legal obligation**, failure to provide it prevents the provision of the service.

When you are asked for **your consent** to the processing, you will not suffer any consequences in the event of refusal of consent.

Paper or online forms indicate the categories of data for which the provision is mandatory or optional.

HOW IS MY DATA PROCESSED?

The processing may be carried out both with the support of paper documents and IT tools.

The Data Controller makes use of persons authorised to process personal data, trained and instructed on the precautions to be taken to ensure the confidentiality, integrity and availability of personal data. Some figures have specific tasks to ensure the security of information and the protection of personal data, as internal managers.

HOW LONG IS MY DATA STORED?

Personal data will be processed for the time required and by law and/or for the execution of contractual obligations.

WHO WILL BE ABLE TO PROCESS MY DATA?

The data may be communicated, made available and shared in accordance with the law, or in compliance with specific requests of the data subject, also with independent third parties data controllers. There are cases in which the University can also disseminate them, i.e. communicate, make available or for consultation to undetermined subjects. In some cases, the University may enter into joint ownership agreements with other parties and in relation to certain processing operations. In addition, the University operates, for its operation, through subjects linked to the

University through liability agreements. In this section we provide you with an overview of who may become aware of your data as recipients of such communications. At any time you can make a specific request in relation to this point by expressly asking to know to whom your data has been communicated.

Disclosure to third-party controllers

Personal data will not be disclosed to third parties.

Joint controllers

There are no joint owners.

Data Processors

The Data Controller makes use of personal data processors, who are required to comply with the security measures provided for in an agreement entered into pursuant to art. 28 GDPR.

The data processors provide technological services, carry out activities on behalf of the Data Controller, access data for maintenance or data processing, for example for the provision of services related to teaching or other activities necessary to be able to fulfil the services offered by the University or fulfil contractual obligations.

The list can always be requested from the University.

Diffusion

Personal data will be disseminated for the following reasons or in the following context: The data will be published on the University website and on the University's social channels.

WHO DID YOU GET MY DATA FROM?

WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?

In accordance with Articles 15-22 GDPR, the data subject has the right to ...

Right to access data

- You can get confirmation and information about the processing.

Right to rectification

- You can rectify inaccurate data or supplement it.

Right to erasure

- In cases of law you can ask for oblivion.

Right to data portability

- You may receive data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable and interoperable format when the data you provide is processed by automated means and is processed with your consent or on the basis of a contract.- You do not have the right to data portability when the

processing is necessary to perform a task carried out in the public interest or in the performance of public functions or to fulfil obligations Legal.

Right to object to processing

- For special reasons you may object to processing for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority. When processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority or the Supervisory Authority of the Member State in which you reside or habitually work.
