My educational background starts at the University of Pisa, where I graduated in Archaeology of Ancient Near East in 2012. As a student I, participated in numerous excavations and archaeological surveys in Syria, Turkey, Iraq and Italy. During my doctoral studies, I developed an interest in Landscape Archaeology and I directed the Tell Gomel Archaeological Survey (TGAS), an intensive survey of the Navkur Plain (Iraqi Kurdistan): The results of this activity, presented in my thesis, contributed to the diachronic reconstruction of the human settlement in said plain, as well as to the understanding of the ways in which this fertile territory was exploited throughout the millennia and shed light on the importance of the archaeological site of Tell Gomel within the region. In 2019, I got a post-doctoral position as a Research Assistant at the University of Oxford within the project "Endangered Archaeology in the Middle East and North Africa - EAMENA". This opportunity allowed me to improve my knowledge of GIS and photointerpretation, and to enter the field of the protection and monitoring of endangered cultural heritage. My current fieldwork focuses on the Region of Iraqi Kurdistan where I am Deputy Director of the Land of Nineveh Archaeological Project. Most recently I am also active in the field of Public Archaeology and Ethics. I took part in numerous international conferences and workshops (also as invited speaker) and I co-organized several international workshops and one international conference for early career scholars in my field of research. My research results have been published in high-impact international peer-reviewed journals as well as in public-reach venues (such as blogs, newsletters, and nonacademic journals).
